650 Sheep An average entry saw a welcome uplift in the lamb trade with quality in general more consistent and buyers also keener throughout. Again meat needed to maximise interest. This week little weight about but we saw heavy lambs from Sue Amoss to £113 for her usual quality Texels and to 248pkg for standard weights from the same vendor. C C Roots & Sons saw medium lambs to £95 at 45kg and £95.50 (44.5kg). P & R Martin 44kg at £95, Petches Farm saw 44kg lambs to £97.50, R G Aves saw medium weights to £96 (44kg), Mark Taylor to £96.50 (43kg) and the same for 43.5kg with 41kg at £93.50. Standard weight lambs wanted around 38kg with general run 225 from 210pkg if meat. Old Season Lambs a few about, still wanted at lower levels.
