Top this week per kg from H P Smith & Sons for a smart BBX heifer purchased by H G Blake. The same vendor having 214.5pkg for a smart Limousin steer. Les Carr had steers to 209.5pkg and Messrs Keeling had heifers to 220.5pkg and steers to 214.5pkg. Tony Evans Limousin steer to 213.5 from 211.5pkg with heifers to 214.5pkg. Geoff Grover had heifers to 211.5 from 201.5pkg (4 head). H P Marriage & Sons had AAX steer to 208.5 and heifer to 205.5pkg. J Kerr, Ongar Park, had Limousin X heifer to 208.5pkg. Redisham Hall Farm strong quality Limousin steer to 219.5pkg (£1,431.14), R W Revell had Limousin steer to 205.5pkg and Andrew Watts had South Devon steer to 206.5pkg with Limousin X steer to the same pkg. Peppers Farm Partnership saw well-meated Limousin heifer to 202.5pkg and to £1,271.70 a head. O+ steers 170.5 to 192.5pkg depending on finish. All in all, a better feel to the trade.

**653 Sheep** included a better entry of 508 New Season lambs which, despite Monday's reports, found a firm trade throughout with a super run of Bleu de Maine X lambs from John Skinner finding a very keen demand. Top price per head paid by George Debman, Ipswich, for the 2<sup>nd</sup> prize commercial lambs from the Suffolk and Hadleigh Shows, shown by Rebecca Spry and selling to 119pkg. Bures Farm Partners lambs selling to £110 (3 pens), £108.50 etc. John Revett's usual strong lambs to £98, £97, £96.50, £96 etc. Mark Taylor strong lambs to £100 a head with his handyweight lambs around 40kg, £88 to £89 a head. Philip Eagle had an excellent single lamb to £111 a head. Messrs Richardson Bros to £112 a head. Plenty of lambs £85 to £90 with, as always, meat and conformation selling to a premium. Good cover is required but not fat to maximise returns. Old Season lambs reducing in numbers and quality with plenty of weight around.
