62 Cattle Another short entry of 57 prime cattle found another firm trade above recent quotations with averages affected by a few poor cattle which are difficult to place, HOWEVER, all cattle sold and to a competitive trade with 13 buyers bidding around the ring showing the strength of the live selling system. Top this week 228.5pkg paid by Tony Cracknell for a Limousin steer from A Watts, Hainford. The same vendor also having 224.5pkg paid by the same buyer. Michael Bates 218.5pkg for a smart Limousin steer, Ben Whiting Limousin steer to 219.5pkg and 214.5pkg for a BBX steer. Tony Evans Limousin steers to 214.5, 210.5pkg etc. Bill Turtle AAX heifers 213.5, 212.5 and 211.5pkg. Colin Clay Blonde steers to 214.5, 209.5pkg. H P Smith & Sons BBX heifer to 207.5pkg and Les Carr steer to 207.5pkg and heifer to 205.5pkg. Lean, good conformation steers and heifers 190.5 to 202.5pkg. A few secondary sorts include O- Lincoln X steers around the 150pkg and very poor sorts down to 105.5pkg but all included in the averages. Top prices per head this week saw M Bates to £1,409.52, Joe Warne to £1,323.80 and Peppers Farm to £1,334.40.
