The Bentalls having other quality handyweight steers at 233.5, 221.5pkg and heifers to 230.5 etc. J B Farms had steers to 224.5, 215.5, 205.5pkg etc. Messrs Herwin Limousin steer to 212.5pkg, Geoff Grover usual handyweights to 220.5, 210.5, 209.5pkg etc. Bob Manning to 209.5pkg for good steers, Tony Evans usual quality to 227.5pkg for Limousin heifers with steers to 210.5pkg.
