78 Cattle included an average entry of 74 prime cattle and several runs of quality steers and heifers forward which found a strong trade. As always, a wide range in breeds and conformation but buyers for all. Top this week per kg 230.5 for a smart Limousin heifer from Adrian Smith, Bungay, purchased by Colin Byford of Little Clacton, the same vendor having 221.5pkg for a Limousin steer. Geoff Freeman Limousin heifers to 229.5pkg and AA heifer to 225.5pkg. D A J Smith Limousin steer to 217.5pkg, Tony Evans Limousin steer to 216.5pkg and BBX steers to the same price with other steers to 214.5, 213.5pkg etc. R Partridge & Son Ltd had Limousin steer to 223.5pkg, BBX heifer to 214.5pkg and steers to 213.5pkg. M Bloomfield heifers to 213.5 and steers to 208.5pkg. A tremendous run of 15m/o BBX steers from H P Marriage & Sons to 224.5 (2), 217.5pkg etc. Messrs A Heath & Sons BBX 12m/o heifers to 211.5pkg, 205.5pkg (3). Another excellent entry of Limousin X steers and heifers from J B Farms saw steers to 216.5, 212.5pkg (2) and heifers to 212.5pkg and to £1,435.77 the head. The same vendor having £1,406.75 and £1,379.11. D Smith steer to £1,405.55. H P Marriage & Sons steers to £1,367.21, £1,337.63, £1,335.02 etc and plenty of cattle £1,200 upwards. Again, good numbers of traditional bred cattle about saw Belted Galloway steers to £192.5pkg (£1,253.18), Hereford steers to 188.5pkg (2), Shorthorn heifers to 163.51pkg, Red Poll steers to 186.5pkg, White Park steers to 185.5pkg, strong Holstein X cattle to 159.5pkg (£1,363.73). **MORE STILL WANTED.**
