1065 Sheep & 2 Goats found a firm trade with a few pens of lean lambs forward more difficult. Trade less but still well in line with other centres with numbers absorbed by the buyers. Less weight about than usual saw a top price per head of £113 and £108 from Helen Moxey, John Revett to £104 (2 pens), Messrs Soames & Eves to £105. Plenty of medium weight lambs £90 to £99.50. Best white faced standard lambs to £94 from G J Goff Ltd and 241pkg. General run of lambs 215 to 225pkg but, as stated, leaner sorts 200p and under per kg. All included in averages. This is still a vast improvement on last year but it is all needed!!
