David Coe saw medium weight steer to 227.5pkg and Gary Hubert had smart Limousin X heifer to the same price and another at 224.5pkg. Andy Tomson also to the same value at 226.5pkg for a Limousin steer and Geoff Freeman also had 227.5pkg for a very small handyweight steer.
