This week one quarter of the entry of cattle taken for further feeding but included in the averages. Top this week at 253.5pkg for a British Blue X heifer from Pauline Byam whose others made 250.5pkg, both purchased by Tony Cracknell, Ipswich, at £1,460.16 and £1,422.84. Les Carr Limousin heifers to 242.5pkg and steers to 229.5pkg. Charolais heifer from A Heath & Sons to 232.5pkg with BBX heifers 227.5, 225.5pkg (2) etc. Gloucester X steer to 217.5pkg and thicker AAX steer to 218.5pkg. Charolais X steer to 213.5pkg with Holstein fed steers to 205.5pkg. Hereford steers to 198.5pkg, Stabiliser steers to 205.5pkg, Sussex steer to 195.5pkg.
