B K Harvey run of Limousin X steers to 238.5, 236.5pkg and Charolais heifers to 219.5pkg with Stabilisers to 221.5pkg and Hereford steers to 220.5pkg. Heather Blythe had 239.5pkg for a handyweight Limousin heifer with another at 226.5pkg. Strong BBX steers from H P Marriage & Sons found a good demand to £1,567.51 a head and to 231.5pkg with 3 others at 228.5pkg. Ben Whiting's usual quality to 234.5pkg for BBX steers and heifers to 231.5pkg.
