Top per kg this week for a very smart butchers weight heifer at 240.50pkg from A & W Bentall and purchased by Dengie Livestock. The same vendor having steers to 238.5, 236.5 (2), 234.5pkg (2) etc and other heifers to 236.5 and 230.5pkg reflecting the quality of the entry. Good to see Geoff Freeman back with heifers 239.5pkg and steers to 233.5pkg as was Pauline Byam. Les Carr seeing meated Limousin X steers to 237.5, 235.5pkg. R W & D R Coe usual run to 239.5pkg for heifers with others to 233.5pkg and steers to 225.5 and 223.5pkg. Gary and Jim Hubert another good show to 239.5pkg for heifer with others to 234.5 and 232.5pkg. Tony Evans to 233.5pkg for heifer and steers to 234.5, 232.5pkg etc. J B Farms good run of meated steers and heifers to 232.5, 231.5pkg for heifers and steers to 228.5pkg with weight. Adrian Smith Limousin steer to 234.5pkg, R Partridge & Son Ltd quality BBX steer to 234.5pkg and heifer to 228.5pkg. Heather and Graham Blythe strong steer to 224.5pkg, Caleb Rayner having AAX heifer to 228.5pkg and heifer to 225.5pkg. As always, a great trade for traditionally bred cattle seeing Hereford steers to 225.5pkg from George Wright Farms, Red Poll steers to 227.5 and 224.5pkg from Peppers Farm Partnership, Lincoln Red heifer to 219.5pkg from Rand Contracting and very strong South Devon heifers from Tim Knighton to 202.5pkg and to £1,659.35 per head with others to £1,659.35. Peppers Farm to £1,657.35 for AAX steer with Heather and Graham Blythe to £1,605.18 for Limousin X steer. J B Farms to £1,537.81 for Limousin X steer and A & W Bentall to £1,507.84 for Limousin X steer. More cattle could be sold to advantage with good finish and weight not an issue.

Top price per kg 284 from Soames & Eaves with Overbury Hall to 283pkg for very smart Texel lambs, the same price per kg from Clive Browning-Smith. J A Farming also at 281pkg for 31kg lambs. G D Black & Son excellent run of well bred lambs around 40kg and pen after pen 270 from 260pkg. Stronger lambs averaging 47-49kg, 260 to 272pkg from John Revett.
