Top price per head this week £139 a head from J W Brown & Sons. £138.50 for Texel x from W J Griffin. Young Alistair Robinson £130 a head. Meated lambs wanted throughout with buyers keen to purchase quality. All lambs in the market averaged £113.27 a head reflecting the demand at this centre.
