360 Sheep disappointingly short entry of 340 lambs with the wet weather affecting presentation. Trade slightly more difficult BUT those forward selling at a good level of demand. More stock wanted please and next week we will back to a full attendance of buyers. The heavy lambs included a run of heavy Dorset Tups which sold from 163pkg to 244pkg and to £162 a head (2 pens) from £149 included in averages. Heavy lambs from Will Griffin to £146 a head with David Fenner matching this for 2 pens with others of £143 (2 pens) etc. Medium lambs to £135 from David Fenner with Will Griffin £134, £133 and £131 etc. Standard lambs to £109.50 from J H Chamley with others to £107 (2 pens) etc with C Appleton to £106, £105 etc. Top price per kilo this week saw Will Griffin to 304pkg, 303pkg etc for heavy lambs. Medium lambs to 309pkg again from Will Griffin with 4 other pens 301pkg to 305pkg. Adam Youngman's medium lambs to 300pkg with his standard lambs to 288pkg. Several pens of very wet lambs and also several pens of lean lambs taken to feed. All lambs averaged £122.82 a head in the market.
