HAGAG Ltd showing Limousin heifer to 268.5pkg and steers at 258.5, 255.5pkg. Ben Whiting usual quality to 268.5pkg for a BBX heifer with another at 263.5pkg and steer to 249.4pkg. Peppers Farm Partnership 5 AAX steers and heifers all 247.5 to 254.5pkg. Gary Hubert BBX steer to 268.5pkg and Limousin steers to 260.5pkg. H H Cawston & Son Limousin steer 264.5, 263.5pkg with AAX steers to 255.5pkg. Pauline Byam Limousin x steer to 261.5pkg and BBX steer to 258.5pkg. R G Manning to 254.5pkg for a BBX heifer.
