The same vendor having 274.5pkg for another Limousin X steer and a Blonde X steer at 265.5pkg. G C & J R Hubert to 269.5pkg and 267.5pkg for Limousin X steers. HAGAG Ltd to 257.5pkg (2) for Limousin X steers, R W Coe to 256.5, 255.5, 254.5pkg, again for Limousin X steers. Les Carr to 256.5pkg for Limousin X heifer, W J Broom & Son to 252.5, 251.5pkg for BBX heifers, J W G Dunt & Sons to 252.5pkg for Limousin X heifers. 1117 Sheep A large entry for the time of year found a firm trade in all sections with a wide range of stock forward. New Season lambs in better numbers and easily clearing to a top of £152 from Bures Farm Partners at 49kg with others £150 (2) etc. Medium NSL to £147 and to 336pkg. Standard lambs to 354pkg plus. OSL saw a greater than expected entry with several consignments forward which were not entered. Mixed quality entry with several leaner OSL forward. Another good show of very heavy hogs from Warwick Gill to £145, £143, £141 (3) etc with heavy OSL to 288pkg from J W Peacock for his usual quality. Medium OSL to £135 with several pens and vendors around that figure and to 302pkg, again from Jack Peacock. Standard OSL to £111 a head from G J Goff Ltd and to 292pkg with half meated OSL being taken for further feeding. Other prices of note in the OSL saw Mrs A Taverner to £140 (2), Richard Criddle to £140, Warwick Gill to £145, £143, £141 (4), £140 (6), Jack Peacock to £140 all for heavy OSL. General run of medium OSL to £126, top £135 depending on finish with leaner sorts £116 to £121.
