Again, majority of hoggets travelling from surrounding countries and from the south with weight paying. Top per head this week saw Tom Buck at £136 and Tom Woodroofe to £135, £130 (4), £128 (3) etc. David McLellan to £131, Jack Peacock to £130.50, £130 (9 pens) etc. Clive Bird also to £130 as were G D Black & Son (2 pens). Medium hoggets to £124.50 from Tom Buck, £121 from Clive Bird (2), G D Black & Son to £120 as was John Bacon. Standard hoggets to £103.50, £102 from Tom Buck but several leaner hoggets under 39kg £80 to £85 a head. Top price per kg this week saw John Bacon at 296pkg for medium weight, Mark & Jake Taylor to 283pkg and many pens 270pkg upward. Standard hoggets to 279, 276pkg from Tom Buck.
