71 Cattle A disappointing entry in terms of numbers with less finished cattle turning up than entered with an animated trade with best cattle totally short of requirements resulting in prices increasing sharply. More cattle urgently required to maintain interest of buyers with some unable to open their accounts. Only 4 cattle below 224pkg and these all extreme Holsteins which traded to 210.5pkg from 149.5pkg and included in steer average. Top per kg this week Ben Whiting, East Anglian Trailers Ltd to 297.5pkg for a very smart BBX heifer purchased by Colin Byford, Little Clacton (£1,609.48), Ben having Limousin steers to 283.5pkg (£1,737.86) and 279.5pkg (£1,590.36) with another heifer at 278.5pkg. Geoff Freeman usual quality handyweight steers to 289.5pkg, 287.5pkg and 286.5pkg. Les Carr Limousin steer to 274.5pkg, A Heath & Sons usual run of dairy X heifers again a fast trade to 270.5pkg for BBX with Limousin X to 269.5pkg and Blonde X to 255.5pkg.
