

Best heavy OSL wanted peaking at £165 a head (61kg) from Warwick Gill who had 3 pens at £160 with others £155, £152. Glyn Goodman to £155, £150 etc. Medium OSL to £140 from both Warwick Gill and Glyn Goodman with E J & V C Fenton's superb lambs to £137 (42.5kg), also W B French & Son at the same price per head. Standard OSL to £129, again from the Fentons with Lawford Hall Farm Partnership to £118 and Clive Bird and G D Black & Son to £114. The Fentons topping the pkg at 331pkg for their Standard OSL with Medium OSL from the same vendor to 329, 325, 322 pkg etc. Heavy OSL from Glyn Goodman to 315, 310, 309pkg etc with Warwick Gill also to 310pkg.
